The Graduate School of Environment and Information Sciences, Yokohama National University is planning to start the Spring Semester classes on Friday, April 8, 2011 as initially scheduled. However, with regard to probable late arrival of incoming students affected by the disaster and international students concerned about the atomic power plant emergency, the EIS takes following measures.

1. Admission procedure

If you cannot finish your admission procedure by the end of March, make contact with the Academic Affairs Section of the EIS (Gakumu Kakari) and your host professor either by e-mail or fax as early as possible by the end of April, and tell your name, admission number and the reason why you cannot finish admission procedure by the end of March. Then EIS will extend the deadline of the completion of admission procedure.

2. Orientation (Both new and current students)

Visit the Academic Affairs Section of the EIS office (Gakumu Kakari) as soon as you start attending the classes. The EIS staff will give you the materials and guidance necessary for you to start the study.

3. Registration of classes

The normal registration period is from April 18th (Monday) to April 19th (Tuesday). You can register by logging-in to the academic affairs system of YNU (You can access the system even from outside the YNU campus. URL: <https://vpngate.ipc.ynu.ac.jp/>). However, if you cannot complete registration in the above period, please visit the Academic Affairs Section of the EIS office (Gakumu Kakari) as early as possible by the May 31st, 2011.

4. Absence from school
