Yokohama National University's Graduate School of Environment and Information Sciences offers applicants living outside Japan the opportunity to take the entrance examination for its doctoral program without coming to Japan. Students may become matriculated in the program at two different times during the school year, April and October. We are currently seeking students for matriculation in either October of 2011 or April of 2012.

If you wish to apply for enrollment, please read guidelines carefully, make sure that you accurately understand the necessary information, and then correctly carry out the application procedures.

This graduate school is composed of several research fields, and the number of applicants that can be accepted in each field is different. Therefore, applicants should find the field in which they want to major, consult with the academic advisor in charge of that field, and then proceed with the application. Moreover, classes in this graduate school are as a rule conducted in Japanese, but some of our faculty members are able to provide academic supervision in English, so please check with the academic advisor in charge of your preferred field about the level of Japanese proficiency required.
