The norm change process involves customers' deviation from the norm (errors, accidents, and misunderstandings) serving as a proposal to change the norms, with the stores generating new norms by adjusting the accidents, compulsions, and disagreements. If a new norm was not set, the norms were compulsorily maintained in order to adjust the discordance between the customers' usage method and the store's usage application. Consequently, norms were modified or maintained without the customers and stores intending to do so due to their dependence on the current status quo.
