WATANABE Tomoyuki	ANDO Takatoshi	A study of care staffs' supports in the field of group home for disabled persons – A survey research design for gathering data individually –	The purpose of this study is to clarify the factors by which the care staffs support disabled persons living in the group home better, and to propose useful insights in practice. The data of support needs gathered by the 'survey research design for gathering data individually' were analyzed in detail by the background of care staffs or disabled persons. Finally, it was clarified that if the disability level and type of disabled persons differ, not only the variation of care staffs' supports, but also the structure of the supports differs, and the experience as the care staff is important to grasp the support needs properly.

OZAKI Tsukasa	ANDO Takatoshi	Development of the Childcare Internship Program making use of an Internship Assessment Rubric integrated the ICT : Toward the amelioration of the evaluation process and the reflection by the Episodic Matching Method	This paper aims to develop a new childcare internship program, by focusing upon the internship rubric for a performance-based assessment. As a result, we have developed an internship activity modeled by OODA loop and also a new program on the Childcare Internship. We observed that these new tools and ICT system could produce immediate feedback and facilitate a useful reflection between during and right after the internship.
